## 2017 Summer Camps and Ballet Intensive

In the unique setting of America's urban National Park, Presidio of San Francisco, Presidio Performing Arts Center (PPAC) opens its doors to young campers from 2.5-12 years of age. Students will enjoy dance, music, singing, acting, musical theatre, fencing, and pantomime. Arts & crafts projects will be presented to further enhance the experience, revolving around stage design, costuming, and make-up artistry.

Our mission is to bring the world of performing arts into the lives of children and summer camp is a wonderful time for cultural enrichment. Classes are based on the international repertoire of the award-winning Presidio Dance Theatre and taught by PDT's Professional Artists and Choreographers. High-level Youth Company students act as mentors for the small children, enhancing the experience. Each week camp ends with a FRIDAY SHOW for parents and friends to enjoy.

PPAC is on the Presidio's Main Post, surrounded by a beautiful green meadow bordered by views of the SF Bay and historic forest.

Young students receive an orientation to dance focused on improving a variety of basic motor skills and expression. Children explore rhythm and movement while learning the fundamental elements of choreography. Students are exposed to a diverse range of cultural dance styles, international music and elementary principles of pantomime, which combined are sure to spark an interest in the arts. They will also enjoy arts and crafts projects, story telling, and Musical Theatre — all at the Presidio of San Francisco.

Students enjoy a ballet-based exploration of the world of dance and performing arts, drawing from a variety of international cultures and illustrious folk traditions. All classes are professionally choreographed, exposing dance theatre traditions shared from generation to generation. Lessons are designed to improve technical skills, coordination, and concentration, cultivate artistry and an appreciation of music. Instruction also covers health and nutrition, make-up and hair for stage, video critique, theatre history, musical theatre and fencing for the stage. Students also participate in imaginative arts and crafts projects related to dance.

#### Cancellation or Refunds

For cancellations up to 2 weeks prior to the beginning of camp, 75% of the tuition is refunded. No refund will be given for cancellations after the 2-week deadline. If a camp does not fill, PPAC reserves the right to cancel, and will issue a full refund for the session.

Written confirmation and camp packet are mailed for all registrations. If a weekly session is full, you will be contacted and added to a wait list. Should space become available, we will notify you via phone and hold the space for 24 hours.

A limited number of partial scholarships are available for ALL camp sessions.
